

We host 1 investigation per business day

(On average)

NRPS (Police) gather evidence & determine criminal charges

FACS determines child protection needs & assign special support staff to families during & after investigation

FCC provides follow up counselling support

Partners may call in medical personnel to assess children

KFCACN hosts investigators, **greets** families & directs incoming calls

Children report being less scared



When working as investigation teams, professionals better understand each other's team roles, improve team results through case review & fewer children fall through the cracks

CACs refer more children for both mental health services & preventative & injury related medical exams

At an estimated savings of 32% CAC coordinated investigations are more cost effective than non CAC run investigations
